The Committee observed a moment of silence for long-time faculty member, Don Cummins who passed away in September.

The report from the Education Foundation Committee, held virtually on September 20, 2023, was presented by Barry Kramer.

The Global, Resort and Second Home Markets Committee, held on October 3, 2023, report was delivered by Lanie Bittner.

Faculty Development Chair, Mike Smith, presented the sub-committee's report from their September 20, 2023, meeting, including:

- A review of the April 2023 instructor development program on online presentation techniques, presented by Jeremias Maneiro.
- The announcement of Carmen Cartegena as the newest member of the NYSAR faculty.

Local Board Education Forum Vice-Chair, Mike O'Connor, presented the committee's report from their September 20, 2023, meeting. Highlights included:

- A Real Estate Board update provided by John Clement, NYS Department of State's Senior License Exam Specialist;
- 97% of 2023 NYSAR courses received a rating of excellent or above average;
- NYSAR faculty received an overall rating of 96% for courses taught during 2023;
- For the first half of 2023, enrollments were 2495. Total 2022 enrollments were 7024;
- Ashton Gustafson presented to the committee on time management; and
- MREI Recertifications have been postponed until 2025.

A motion was made and passed to recommend that the Article 12a working group draft

legislation requiring all real estate licenses to complete one hour of sexual harassment training as set forth in NYS labor law section 201-g(2)(a & b).

Marki Lemons Rhyal presented a program on how REALTORS® can embrace AI and ChatGPT in education and business to revolutionize processes and systems.
