

LEGAL ACTION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Legal Action Committee reviewed the financials and current legal matters supported by NYSAR.

The Legal Action Committee approved up to \$40,000 to draft a brief in the Pusatere v City of Albany appeal to the NYS Court of Appeals taking the position that local Good Cause Eviction laws are preempted by state law.

The Legal Action Committee approved up to \$45,000 in funding to the Hudson Valley Property Owners Association to challenge recent changes to the Tenant Protection Act requiring landlords to provide 3 years of rent rolls to municipalities that pass the Tenant Protection Act.

NYSAR counsel provided a Legal Department update. Legal hotline volume is still up as compared to pre-COVID volume. The calling trend has shifted from COVID related questions to real estate practice related questions. NYSAR attorneys have returned every call made during this time.

The Legal Department will continue to offer a free monthly legal update course through Zoom for one hour of CE credit.
