Chair updated the committee on the hearings for 2024. She also discussed the upcoming trainings NYSAR is putting together in 2024. Mediation/Mediator and Ombudsman training will be held at the Desmond in either April or September, more to come. Professional Standards Training will be held via zoom April 3 and 4, 2024 from 9am-1pm.

Chair, introduced Diane Mosely, NAR Director, Training and Policy Resources. Diane thoroughly discussed the 2024 changes to the Code of Ethics and Arbitration manual, to include language changes on several forms and guidelines.

Chair, introduced Matt Troiani, NAR Senior Counsel, Director Legal Affairs. Matt discussed “What leaders and brokers need to know after the Burnett verdict”. He reminded members to utilize [competition.realtor](https://www.competition.realtor) to stay up to date or they can email Matt directly.
