Members of NYSAR's 8th Leadership Academy (LA8) will be immersed in a comprehensive program that will develop skills in the many facets of successful leadership. The program will often focus on REALTOR® association leadership but is also designed to introduce skills that will affect all facets of your personal and professional life.

The 2025 academy class will be comprised of 12 REALTOR® members. There will be five sessions at locations across New York State. The dates and themes are listed below. Sessions begin on Sunday night with a group dinner and conclude Tuesday afternoon, with the exception of the last session which is held in conjunction with the Fall Business Meetings.

To ensure maximum benefit for all participants, you must fully attend all five sessions. Failure to attend all sessions or missing any portion of a session will result in expulsion and loss of your tuition. Upon successful completion of the program, there will be a graduation ceremony at the NYSAR Fall Business Meetings where you will be presented a certificate of graduation and a recognition pin. Graduates will also gain a lifetime of memories and friendships. Tuition is \$1,000 and must be paid in full upon acceptance to LA8, and no later than November 1, 2024.

Tuition includes all course materials, overnight accommodations, breakfast (2) /lunch (2)/dinner (2), and refreshments.
